What is MOD®?

Managing your pain is critical to your recovery. That's why your doctor has ordered the MOD® device for you. MOD® means Medication on Demand. There's no more waiting for your medication to be delivered ... it's already at your bedside!

- **MOD® is programmed so you can get your pain pill at the right time, every time.**

If your doctor has written an order for you to receive a pain pill every three hours, the MOD® device will make a pain pill available to you every three hours. If you decide you're not quite ready for your pill, MOD® will be ready when you are ... but not before the prescribed time.

- **MOD® tracks your pain levels so your doctors and nurses can better monitor and help control your pain.**

You must always record your pain level before you can access your medication. If you don't register your level of pain, the MOD® won't dispense your medication!



Prior to obtaining your pain medication, you must first touch the number that best represents your pain level.

How do I use MOD®?

The device is very simple to use. When the small light on the MOD® glows green, you have access to your pain pill.



1. Begin by touching a number on the front of the MOD® that best describes your pain level.



2. Slowly place your wristband at the center of the MOD®'s pain scale panel to open the medication tray.



3. When the tray opens, take out your pain pill. You have 45 seconds to remove your pill.
